



xGPS Module

Quick start guide

Please follow carefully the following steps to use the xGPS module with your iPhone® 2G (first generation) or with your iPod Touch®.

1. Use an iPhone first generation or an iPod Touch only. The device should be « jailbroken ». You can follow the tutorial to do it, here, for Windows:

2. Install the xGPSUtil software on your iPhone / iPod Touch:
 - Open the Cydia software on your device (iPhone or iPod Touch).
 - Tap on Manage and then on Sources.
 - Press the *Edit* button and then the *Add* button.
 - Enter the following text in the window and press *Add Source*:
<http://cydia.xwaves.net/>
 - After a while the button *Return to Cydia* appears, click on it.
 - Tap on the Xwaves entry of the list shown and select the xGPS Util package by tapping on it.
 - Tap on the Install button. The xGPS Util software will then appears on your home screen.
3. Lock your iPhone / iPod Touch screen by pressing the button on its up side.
4. Connect the xGPS Module to your iPhone / iPod Touch using the dock connector. Be sure to have the dock connector logo on the top and press the two buttons on the sides of the connector to plug it in the iPhone or iPod Touch. Just ignore, by pressing No, any message coming from an iPhone when your plug the xGPS Module in.
5. Unlock your iPhone / iPod Touch screen and start the xGPSUtil software from your home screen.
6. Tap on Enable GPS button to get your position and speed.
7. To disconnect the xGPS module, press the two buttons on the sides of the dock connector and then **gently** pull it. **Do not pull on the cable.**
